27th Annual SSE Meeting

Our theme this year is “*Emerging Paradigms at the Frontiers of Consciousness & UFO Research*” and we have invited the following speakers:

Experiments Involving Consciousness include Professor Todd L. Richards, “Functional Magnetic Resonance Imaging and Electroencephalographic Evidence of Correlated Brain Signals Between Physically and Sensory Isolated Subjects,” Dean Radin on “Evidence of Correlated Brain Signals between Physically and Sensory Isolated Events” and remote viewer Paul Smith on “Why ESP is Consciousness’ Only Hope.”

In the Space/UFO arena we have invited former Canadian Secretary of Defence Paul Hellyer to discuss the view from Canada, Patrick Skipper will present “New Strong Evidence of Current Surface Water and Life on Mars and Its Implications,” and Program Chair Robert Wood will present an “Evaluation of Two Original-paper ‘Leaked’ UFO Documents.”

Physics and Consciousness. Bernie Haisch will speak on “The Fine Tuning of Laws and Constants of the Universe: Two Explanations;” Satya Dev Negi, a representative of the Dalai Lama, will speak on “Implications of Buddhism on Consciousness Research,” and Claude Swanson on “The Common Elements of Parapsychology and UFO Experiences: Lessons for Physics.”

We invite all full members of the SSE to submit papers relevant to these topic areas, and also welcome papers on any subject regarded vital to scientific exploration in the context of SSE goals. Associate members may submit papers if sponsored by full members. All papers will be incorporated into the final program. **Deadline for submitting abstracts is midnight April 28.** All submissions should include a one-page abstract provided by the speaker. Authors are encouraged to use tables or graphs creatively and these should be submitted in PDF format. Text should be submitted in Microsoft Word. **Abstracts should preferably be sent by email to Bob Wood (drbobwood@sbcglobal.net)** or alternatively mailed to 1727 Candlestick Lane, Newport Beach, CA 92660. Other members of the Program committee include Host Dominique Surel, Courtney Brown, Bill Bengston and ex officio President Garret Modell.
